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GENERAL FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ As a general rule I feed purina O.N.E. Lamb and Rice (adult)
- 6-12 week old puppies: I soak their food with water (no milk). They eat about 3/4 to 1 cup (dry), then I pour a little water over their feed. I let this soak for about 5 minutes. (I feed twice a day).
- 12-16 week old puppies: I start them on dry O.N.E. (sometimes this varies depending on the puppy) As the puppy gets older increase his food. If you only have one puppy, I find it easier to feed a puppy free choice (leaving his food out at all times). Then the puppy can eat when he gets hungry. This sometimes helps the puppies not be too much of a pig.

ALWAYS REMEMBER TO GIVE YOUR PUPPY FRESH WATER

GENERAL INFO - HELPFUL HINTS

If you think your dog stinks, check his ears and try to keep his ears clean. This may be where your smell is coming from.

Your puppy loves squeaky soft plush toys. They love to carry things in their mouth. always keep something for them to play with.

I also let my puppies chew on Nylabones. i prefer this over rawhide bones --(these seem to sour on their stomach and what a mess to clean up.)

I prefer to teach my puppies to love a crate. This helps them to know that this is their special place for them or a safe haven for them. This also helps you to know that your puppy is being a good puppy! Basically when puppies leave my home they are crate broke (meaning that they have been in a crate overnight or during the heat of the day here in Mississippi.
